



Building on the property, however, meant devising a detailed construction plan that would meet the lengthy regulations and deed restrictions. With myriad challenges ahead, the couple turned to architect Maho Abe who, with assistant Rina Okawa, conceived an extensive rebuilding plan based on Asian design principles.
